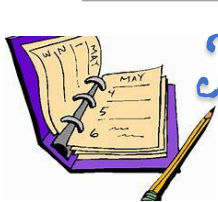


A huge thank you to the Easter Bunny for coming to school today and giving every child a chocolate egg. A wonderful start to the Easter holidays!
